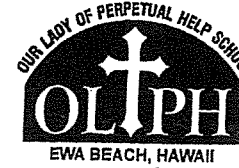

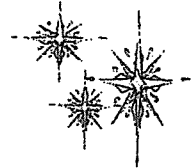
**TERRANOVA & INVIEW

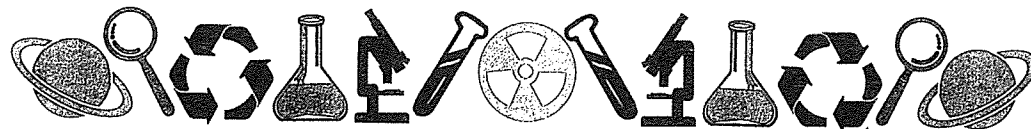

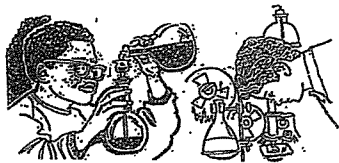
