We will also view the video "The Kings Noble Vision" and tour the surrounding areas of the 'Iolani Palace.

**'Io** is the Hawaiian hawk, a bird that flies higher than all the rest, and **lani** denotes heavenly, royal, or exalted. The first palace, **Hale Ali'i** (House of the chief) was demolished in 1874. Kamehameha V changed its name to 'Iolani Palace in honor of his late brother and predecessor.

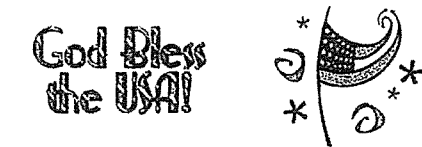
